IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE HEALTH OFFICE

Health Days are going to be September 27th and 28th this year. (For new parents/students this means “health screenings” for all students.) The Diocese of Tucson requires various screening assessments be done as specified for each grade level. With the help of our PALS, we will be screening all students during these two mornings. Any student failing a screening will be scheduled for a re-screen. If the student fails a second time, a referral will be sent home.

Sixth, seventh, and eighth graders will be offered A FREE EKG by a cardiologist. Please look for the permission forms included in this week’s School Express!

On Wednesday, October 4th, our vision screening will be completed by the Lion’s Club. Another notification will be sent home next week to remind you to make sure all glasses are worn that day.
